

Elevate Salon Institute establishes a criterion regarding the transfer of credit hours earned from another school as listed below:

- All accepted transfer hours will be credited at the beginning of the program.
- A possibility exists that no transfer credits will be granted.
- Students transferring from another franchise location of Salon Professional Education Company will be placed into an existing class based on level of completion recorded on their transcript.
- Courses with an 85% or higher grade will be eligible for transfer hour's credit with a maximum of 100% of the student's completed hours allowable for transfer in general education chapters.
- Tuition balances do not transfer from one school to another.
- A student wishing to transfer may be accepted to an educational course/ program after carefully evaluating the student's academic records. Each transfer is evaluated on an individual basis.
- Transfer evaluations consist of a practical and theory evaluation. The prospect is responsible for all equipment regarding transfer testing. No tools or supplies will be provided regarding practical assessment.
- A determination on the number of hours transferred in will be provided regarding practical assessment.
- A determination on the number of hours transferred in will be made within 5 business days of transfer evaluation. This evaluation must be completed before enrollment, and the student will be made aware of the number of hours able to transfer.
- Prior schooling must be within 3 calendar years to be eligible for transfer evaluation or the transfer of hours.

Elevate Salon Institute has an established Articulation Agreement with the following:

- Elevate Salon Institute does not have an articulation agreement with any other schools.

Reciprocity and requirements for Elevate Salon Institute:

- Licensed cosmetologists, estheticians, manicurists, massage therapist, cosmetology instructors and limited specialty instructors from Michigan may apply for licenses in their field of expertise in other states. Graduates must comply with each state's laws and rules to become licensed.
- Elevate Salon Institute offers educational programs in the state of Michigan that only apply to licensing in the state of Michigan. The Institute has not determined if courses may transfer to any other state.
- The state(s) that the school has determined the above programs meet curriculum educational requirements for licensure and certification is Michigan. The school has not determined if the programs meet curriculum educational requirements for licensure and certification in any other state.
